

**Alabama Department of Human Resources
MODERATE RESIDENTIAL SERVICES FOR CHILDREN
Evaluation Results and Award Information**

The Alabama Department of Human Resources received responses from twenty-eight (28) vendors interested in providing moderate residential services to children in the custody of the state. The Moderate Residential Request for Proposals (RFP) announced the availability of 300 slots to be awarded and a contract start date of October 01, 2007. Vendors proposed to provide a total of 773 slots, more than double the number of slots to be awarded. The results of this procurement are as follows:
