Q1. Section 3.1.9 AFTERCARE SERVICES (page 16)

Is there an expectation that aftercare services will include face-to-face contact with the family or will periodic phone consultation at prescribed intervals after discharge suffice?

R1. Aftercare services will be based upon the needs identified in the family's ISP.

Q2. Pg 15, section 3.0 project overview

This describes working with Moderate and TFC providers to move children into relative or family homes. In the Pre-proposal conference, the group targeted for this New program was expanded to be any child in out of home placement to be considered for referral as long as reunification /placement with relative is considered ...is that correct?

R2. The project is for all children in out-of-home care, but those in the more restrictive treatments of Moderate, TFC and Intensive will be the ones served first.

Q3. Same section 3.0,

As asked in the pre-proposal conference, is there any specific reason why this was issued as a "stand alone" program rather than a part of Moderate programs or TFC programs who already have established working relationships with the families?

R3. This project is based upon a pilot that has been successful in Jefferson and other counties.
