Changes have been made to the document as originally issued. See the changes below.

3.0 PROGRAMMATIC INFORMATION

(Second paragraph, last sentence)

The role of the team will be to work with the county office to develop Wraparound plans (ISP); plan for crisis; support the implementation of the plan; access informal and formal resources/supports; monitor services; inspire unconditional care; and, provide therapeutic ~~for~~ ~~care~~ ~~of~~ the family for up to one year.

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3.13 MEDICAID BILLING

~~Vendors must indicate that the vendor is able to bill by meeting all Medicaid criteria. The monthly rate for this Wraparound Team service will be paid to the provider upon receipt of invoice and documentation. The Department will have an expectation that providers will bill for all Medicaid services performed for Medicaid eligible children.~~

3.13 MEDICAID BILLING

Medicaid billing is **not** an option for this procurement.

5.0 COST PROPOSAL

~~Vendors must provide one fixed daily rate needed to perform the services outlined in Appendix E. The provider should provide an explanation of what items make up the costs of their program and percentage of those expenditures to total costs. **EXAMPLE: If the total cost of the program is 600,000 per year (daily rate X 365 days) the following items make up the total cost:**~~

- ~~Personnel 45% Total personnel costs for the program including percentage of administrative personnel.~~
- ~~Travel 5% Costs for employees to work with child and family, not conference or training travel.~~
- ~~Equipment 20% Leased or purchased equipment that represent costs to the program.~~
- ~~Other 30% Indirect costs or sub-contractual costs related to the program.~~



5.0 COST PROPOSAL

The rate structure for this procurement is as follows:

In home room and board	\$1,970.00
Out-of-home room and board for one child	\$3,442.97
Add on rate for each additional child in out- of-home	\$1,721.49

Example: A vendor receives a referral on a reunification family. At the time of the referral the monthly rate for the vendor would be in home room and board rate of \$1,970.00. In serving the family it becomes necessary to serve one of the children outside of the home there new rate would now be the out of home rate for one child which is \$3,442.97. If an additional child had to be put in an out of home placement an additional \$1,721.49 which would raise the rate from \$3,442.97 to \$5,164.46.

Note: Fixed rates are specified for this procurement for the provision of services, proposals exceeding either of the fixed rates will be deemed non-responsive and no further consideration will be given.
