

## ALABAMA'S EBT ISSUANCE SCHEDULE

### FOOD ASSISTANCE (SNAP)

Ongoing monthly Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits are issued over a span of 20 days each month based on the last two digits of the case number starting with the date of the 4<sup>th</sup> and ending with the 23<sup>rd</sup>. \*

- Monthly – SNAP benefits are available the same calendar date each month.
- Daily – SNAP benefits are available the next day after they are entered in the system if the benefit is for the past month or the current month.
- Residents of Drug and Alcohol Treatment Centers – Special issuance provisions are used for these SNAP benefits. One half of the regular monthly allotment is available on the 4<sup>th</sup> of the month and the remaining one half of the allotment is available on the 16<sup>th</sup> of the month.

Note: \*This change is effective beginning September 2013.
