**FAMILY ASSISTANCE**

Payments by the Department for child care of children totaled \$14,199,763.76 for 39,544 children for the month of January. This included payments totaling \$13,484,535.58 for 37,253 children in Licensed Child Care Centers, \$601,953.84 for 1,613 children in Family and Group Day Care Homes, and \$113,274.34 for 678 children in Informal Care. The average monthly payment per child was \$359.09.

**SOCIAL SERVICES**

Children receiving payment from the Foster Care Maintenance Payments program provided through County Departments of Human Resources numbered 1,891 for the month of January. The maximum board payment from the Department is based on the age of the child and is as follows: 0-2 years, \$410.00; 3-5 years, \$423.00; 6-12 years, \$434.00; and 13-18 years (19 if last year in high school), \$446.00. The average board payment per month may be less than the maximum because some of the children included have board payments made partially from private funds and because some children do not remain at board for a full month. In some instances the average board payment may exceed the maximum because certain children are eligible for nursing care or special care.

**SOCIAL SERVICES**

Children receiving payment from the Aid to Children in Foster Care program provided through County Departments of Human Resources numbered 2,352 for the month of January. The maximum board payment from the Department is based on the age of the child and is as follows: 0-2 years, \$410.00; 3-5 years, \$423.00; 6-12 years, \$434.00; and 13-18 years (19 if last year in high school), \$446.00. The average board payment per month may be less than the maximum because some of the children included have board payments made partially from private funds and because some children do not remain at board for a full month. In some instances the average board payment may exceed the maximum because certain children are eligible for nursing care or special care.

The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program, established by the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA), required states to provide work and training services to recipients of Family Assistance (FA). Called JOBS in Alabama, the program emphasizes work activities and employment of recipients. Child care and other supportive services are available to JOBS participants. The Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 (DRA) made significant changes to TANF requiring states to operate a more intensive JOBS Program and drastically increased the documentation and tracking requirements.
