Dear Commissioner Buckner:

Thank you for submitting Alabama's Annual Progress and Services Report (APSR) for fiscal year (FY) 2026, including the annual report on the use of funds under the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act, and the CFS-101 forms requesting funding for FY 2026 to address the following programs:

- Title IV-B, subpart 1 of the Social Security Act (the Act) the Stephanie Tubbs Jones Child Welfare Services Program;
- Title IV-B, subpart 2 of the Act the MaryLee Allen Promoting Safe and Stable Families Program and Monthly Caseworker Visit Grant);
- Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA) State Grant;
